The Legion will have final Officer nominations, for the 2024-2025 year, during our meeting at 7:30 on April 22nd. The Elections for Legion Officers will be held on Saturday, May 11th from 10am-6pm, if needed.

The Auxiliary, SAL and Riders are in the middle of Officer nominations for the 2024-2025 year, with 2nd nominations in April and final nominations/elections in May.

Veterans Service Office (VSO) View



I've received several inquires on benefits for families of Veterans who have gone onto "Post Everlasting". I thought it would be appropriate to share a few notes regarding major benefit entitlements in the 148'r.

- <u>Internment:</u> The VA provides a final resting place (National cemetery) for eligible Veterans, spouses and their eligible dependents and a headstone or marker (national, private, or public cemetery), a U.S. Flag for the decedents family and a Presidential Memorial Certificate.
- ♦ <u>Military Honors:</u> As of January 1, 2000, all eligible Veterans are entitled to military funeral honors (Honor Guard, Bugler). The next of kin, or appropriate individual, <u>MUST</u> request this service. Funeral directors have a Department of Defense Hotline number (1-877-MIL-HONR) to request and coordinate ceremonies. Another resource is https://www.cem.va.gov/military funeral honors.asp.
- Reimbursement of burial expenses: For service-connected deaths on or after September 11, 2001, the VA pays up to \$2000 towards burial expenses. If buried in a National cemetery, some or all of the cost may be reimbursed. For non-service connected deaths, after 1 October, 2023, the VA pays a \$948 burial allowance and \$948 for a plot. Two year filing limit.
- ♦ <u>VA Compensation:</u> The VA typically pays the last monthly disability payment to a surviving spouse. Surviving spouses, dependent children and/or parents of a service member may be eligible for a tax free monthly benefit, not income-based, called Dependent Indemnity Compensation. Survivors pension is an income-based benefit paid to eligible, un-remarried surviving spouses and/ or dependent children of deceased Veterans. Housebound survivors may be eligible for aid and attendance in addition to the survivors pension.

These benefits should be taken care of by your funeral director, if they are aware of Veteran status. Don't hesitate to contact me should you have additional questions on this or any other benefits that may be available.


