

# **Doug Woodring - Veterans Service Officer (VSO)**

## **Greetings Legion Members!**

<u>VA Education Benefits Update:</u> Veterans who served two or more periods of military service will be eligible for up to <u>12 months of additional education benefits</u> under new plans unveiled by Veterans Affairs leaders on 3 January 2025. Veterans who served at least 2 years before being honorably discharged and paid into the Montgomery GI Bill during their time in service can qualify for that program. It pays out roughly \$2,400 a month in education benefits to individuals. The Post-9/11 GI Bill is more generous, awarding full tuition costs for state universities plus housing stipends and other education assistance payments for individuals who served 3 years on active duty after September 2001. Partial benefits are available for anyone who served on active duty for at least 90 days. Previously Veterans couldn't access both benefits simultaneously, and have been required to give up eligibility for one program to access the other. For more information and to better understand all of the changes, you will need to visit <u>VA.gov</u>. Feel free to reach out to me.

The VA Announces Further Presumptive Service Connections: As of Jan. 10, 2025, the VA has established presumptive service connections from exposure to particulate matter for leukemias, multiple myelomas, myelodysplastic syndromes, and myelofibrosis. Eligible Vets must have served on active military, naval, air or space service in Somalia or the Southwest Asia theater of operations on or after Aug. 2, 1990; or in Afghanistan, Syria, Djibouti, Uzbekistan, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, or Yemen on or after Sept. 11, 2001. This interim final rule will ease the evidentiary burden for VA disability compensation claimants with these conditions. If you are impacted by this, please apply at VA.gov or seek an accredited VA service officer like the ones at Veterans Memorial Park.
