

White Elephant Rules

Must bring a gift of \$20 or more. Absolutely NO Gag Gifts!

- 1. Each player brings one wrapped gift to contribute to a common
- 2. Players draw numbers to determine what order they will go in.
- 3. The first player selects a gift from the pool and opens it.
- 4. The following players can choose to either pick an unwrapped gift from the pool or steal a previous player's gift. Anyone who gets their gift stolen in this way can do the same - choose a new gift or steal from someone else.
- 5. Each person will get 3 steals.
- 6. After all players have had a turn, the first player gets a chance to swap the gift he or she is holding for any other opened gift. Anyone whose gift is stolen may steal from someone else (if that person has a steal left). When everyone is out of steals, the game comes to an end. After the first person either steals or keeps their gift, anyone with a steal left may use that steal. We will use the lowest start number and go up until all steals are used.
