### Veterans Service Office (VSO) View

Happy New Year to all of our Members and their families! My name is Doug Woodring, a Pennsylvania Native who has lived in the Tampa Bay area since 1996 and a Riverview resident for over 5 years. I've been the Alafia Post 148 Veterans Service Officer for about 3 1/2 months, taking over for Mike O'Dell, who we thank for his ser-

vice. As a retired Navy Surface Warfare Officer (SWO) Veteran with a 100% permanent and total disabled VA rating. I've been a member of Post 148 for almost 2 years and enjoy the camaraderie at Post 148. I hope to see all of you at the Post General Membership meetings or in the Lounge. You can reach me on my cell, 813-417-0352 or email Ser-

viceOfficer148@Yahoo.com. I am starting this column as a way to communicate with the membership and provide resources available to Veterans and their dependents as well as special events and programs that can save Veterans time, money, and provide helpful information. A few notes for this months 148'r newsletter.

- The VSO is more than just someone to ask about Department of Veteran's Affairs issues. I'm a Post member and family resource, who can connect you with not only VA, but also with community and local government assistance for Veteran's and their dependents.
- I cannot render assistance if I am unaware of a need. If you know of any Veterans in need, please let me know as soon as possible.
- I pledge to do my very best to assist you with your issue. This does not mean there will always be an immediate resolution, but we will work together and with Post leadership to determine the best course of action.
- Check the March calendar, as I will be holding office hours (the good kind) at the Post weekly for a few hours on a firstcome, first-served basis, as I'm retiring from Federal Service on 29 Feb 2024. I feel it's important to make myself available on a regular basis and connect with fellow Vets.
- Veteran Benefit—Have you heard of the Lifeline or the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)? These are FCC programs that can help you save on your monthly cell phone (select carriers), a mobile device, and internet bill. As a Veteran receiving compensation, a VA Pension, or VA survivor benefits, you qualify. Go to https://www.fcc.gov/lifelineconsumers for information, eligibility and enrollment. It's a fairly straightforward process taking a minimal effort on your part to apply and then contact your service provider. You should sign up for Lifeline, if eligible first, as you are then automatically qualified for ACP.
